- Looking to Popcorn Fridays next year:
 - Still looking for someone to take over for Kelly to run Popcorn Fridays beginning next year. Jessica Zahn is willing to co-lead on this; looking for additional co-lead.
 - We'll go back to having students pay before each Popcorn Friday, rather than pre-pay option as we did this year. Teacher's have felt it just works out better.
- Papa Murphy Coupon Cards
 - Profited \$1.225
 - Sold 326 cards
 - Lessons were learned for next year. Overall, this seemed to be a successful fundraiser that wasn't a lot of work for us. Will likely repeat next spring.

New Business

- Night Out Fundraisers
 - Happy Joes set for 3/5. 20% return on all orders (take out, deliver and dine in) mentioning the fundraiser, all day.
 - Chuck E Cheese set for 4/18. 20% return on all dine in orders mentioning the fundraiser for set timeframe.
 - Texas Roadhouse Tabled until next meeting; may put off until next year.
- Give Back Movie Night
 - Dates? We'll confirm date once the Field Day date is set.
 - Entertainment
 - Information/quotes were obtained from both Jim Lenz (science shows/walking magic and/or game rental) and Mischief and Magic (face painting and/or balloon animals)
 - Jim Lenz science shows are for an auditorium audience.
 ~\$400. He stated the up-close walking magic/science is usually a bit less.
 - Likely more than we want to invest for only one entertainer.

- Mischief and Magic recommends at least 2 performers, more if possible.
 - Each entertainer provides approximately 20 balloons or facepaints per hour
 - 2 entertainers (balloon animals or face paint) = \$100 per hour
 - 3+ entertainers = \$75 per hour
 - Possibility, but we'll want to see about other premovie entertainment, such as bouncy house and/or game rental first
- Camera Corner projector rental looks to be \$100; screen rental \$20. Will
 confirm availability and functionality for our event once date for Field Day
 is set.
- Teacher Appreciation Week May 6 May 10
 - Last year we provided a meal or treat each day.
 - o Plan to do the same this year. Solidify at next meeting.
 - Mrs. Manteufel will be retiring at the end of this year. HPSA will do something special for her to commemorate.
- Welcome to Kindergarten
 - We'll want to plan to have a presence to introduce/promote HPSA and have info, available
 - Good and needed opportunity to attract new members
 - Solidify plans at next meeting
- Forward Testing for 3rd and 4th graders is coming up after spring break.
